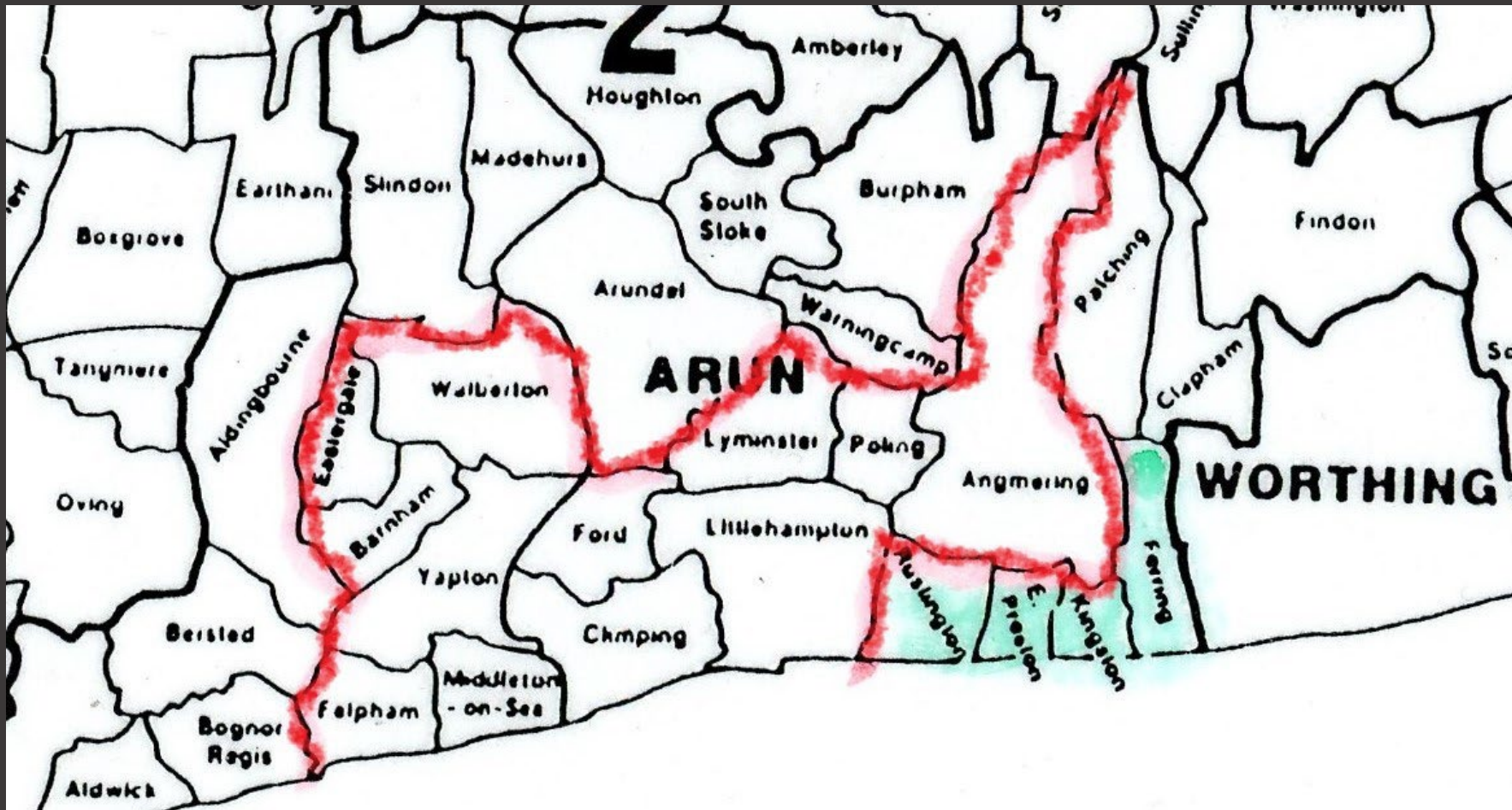

Museum Accreditation



- Accredited with the Arts Council, last awarded 2019
- Encourages all museums to meet an agreed standard in:
 - How they are run
 - How they manage their collections
 - How they engage with their users

Museum Documentation

Previously:

- Collections documented on index cards and in handwritten accessions registers and lists.
- Action point from Museum Accreditation in 2013 : create a plan to document our collection to current industry standards.





Documentation Project Background

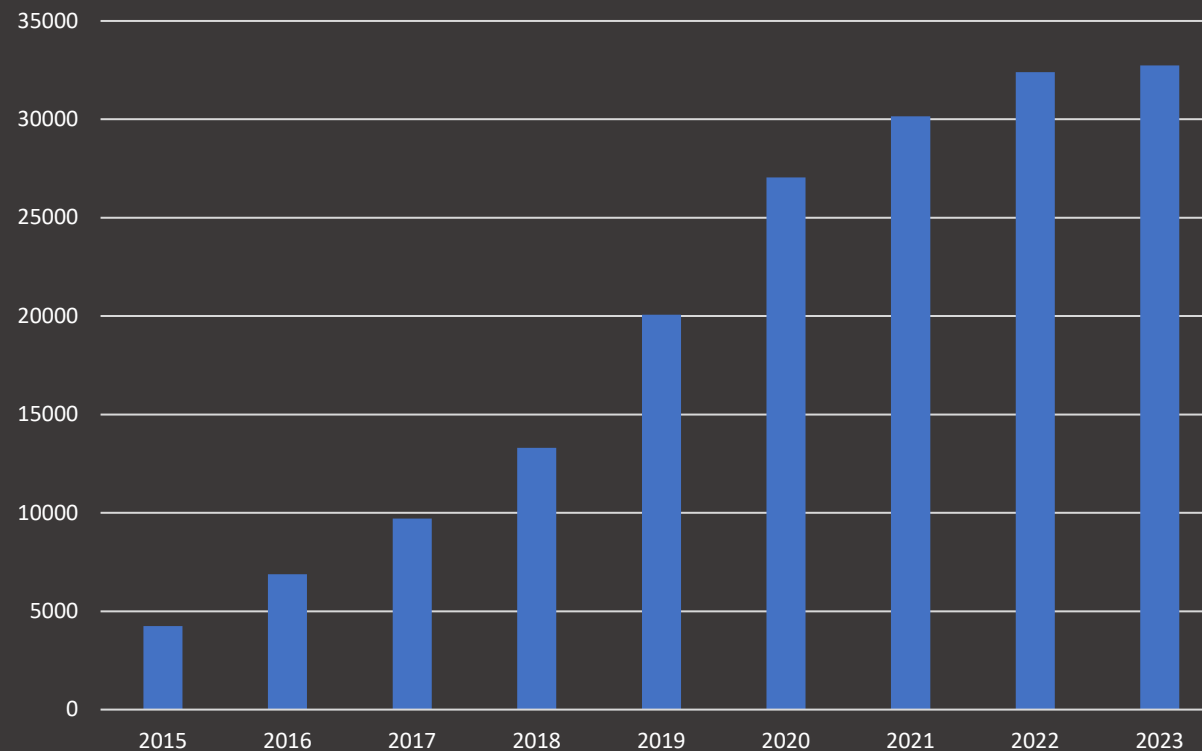
- **2013:** Backlog acknowledged in the Accreditation Return as an area for improvement
- **2016:** Highlighted by Museum Staff as a priority, Documentation Officer post created and efforts are started to tackle the backlog
- **2018:** Museum Working Group meets to discuss way forward
- **2019 to 2021:** Museum Team given time and resources to fully focus on the Documentation Project.

Museum Working Group Recommendations 2018

01	Plans and Procedures	New Plans and policies for Documentation and Collections Management to be put in place
02	Collections Management	Improve Collections Storage, Care, Housekeeping and tackle documentation backlog
03	Staff and Volunteers	Staff and Volunteers trained in documentation and collections management. New volunteers recruited.
04	Visitor Engagement	Exhibitions and Events programme minimised during the project. The public is engaged with the project
05	Finance and Resources	The Museum team should be given the time and resources to focus on the project.

Collections Care and Conservation Policy and Plan

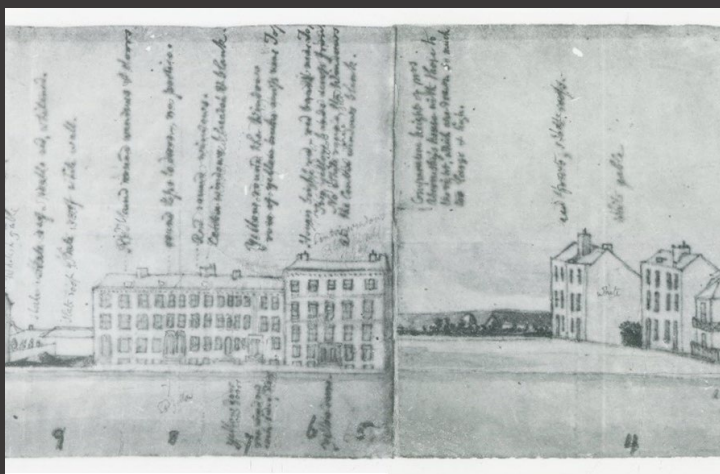

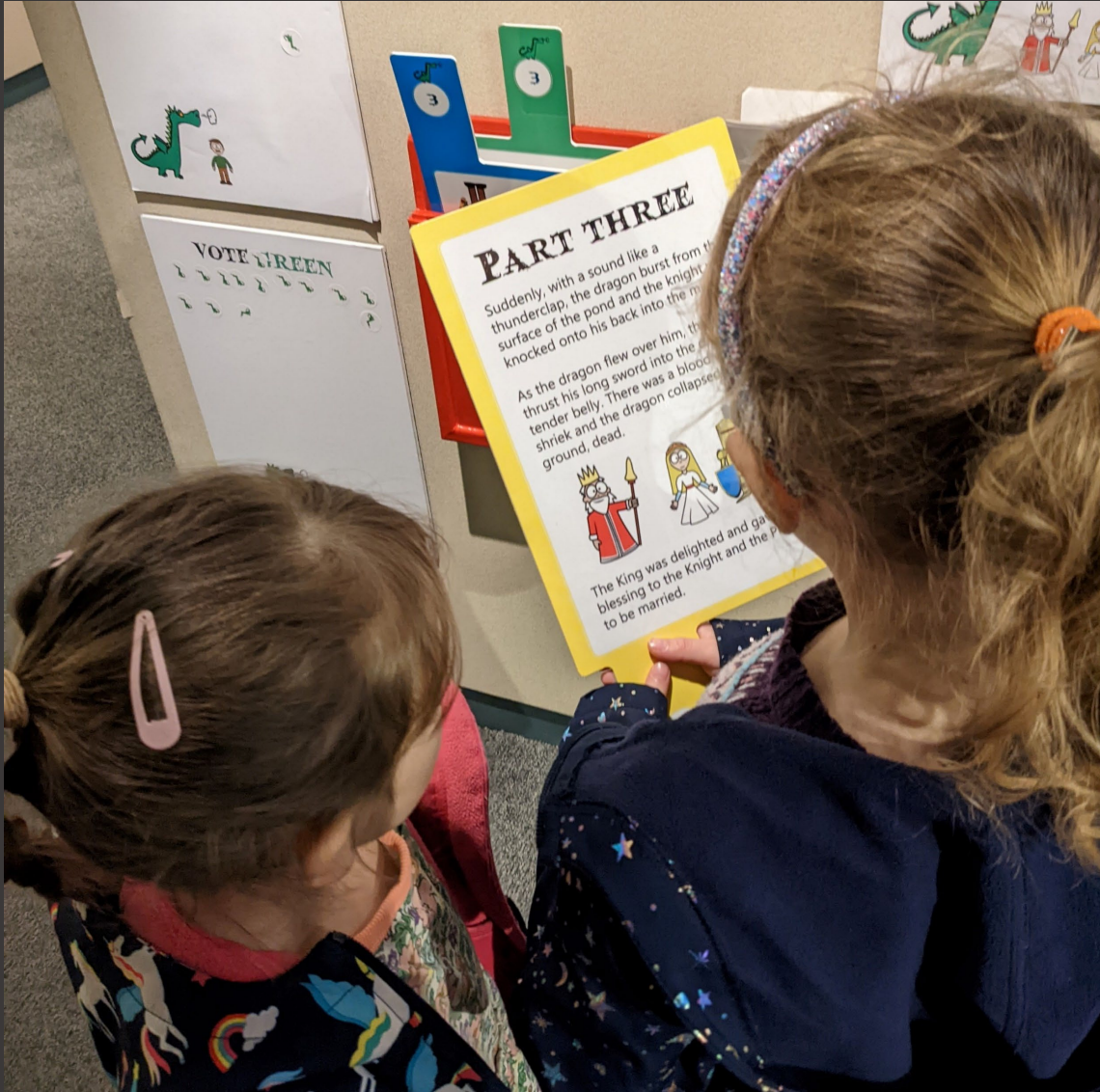


Key collections / items of importance

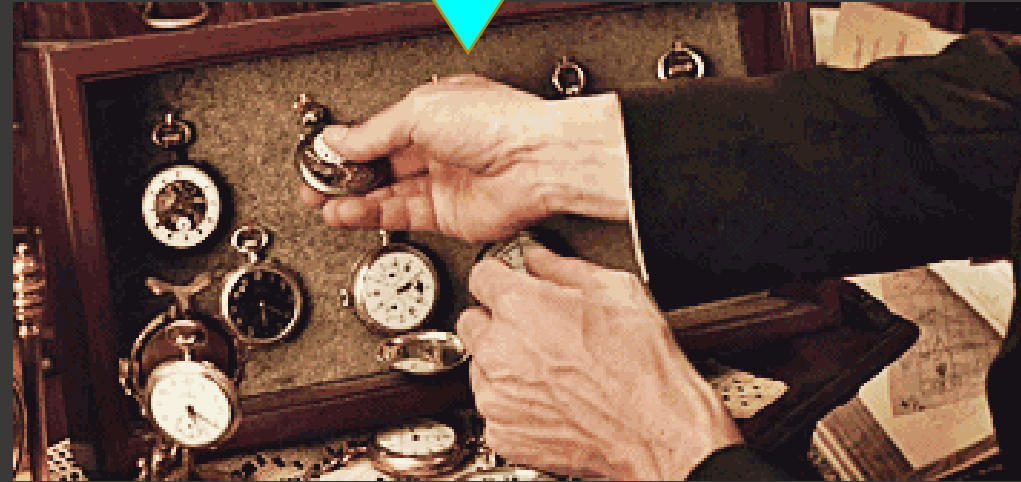
